

J. CREW FALL 2009 SCARF



I saw this in the window of a J. Crew store this fall and knew it would be easy to recreate. They wanted \$49.99 for it... I think not.

Finished Measurements: 20 cm x however long you want it.

Materials:

Knit Picks Wool of the Andes: 3 skeins (or approx 330 yds of worsted weight wool)
1 set US #7 needles

Pattern:

Using long-tail cast on, cast on 33 sts.

[WS] Rib row 1: SI1, *K1, P1* Repeat to end. (If you do not slip the first st, make sure you knit 2 otherwise the center part will be off).

[RS] Rib row 2: SI1, K all sts.

-Repeat these two rows until ribbing measures at least 20 cm and you end at the end of row 1.

[RS] Body row 1 : SI1, K1, P1, K11, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K11, P1, K2.

[WS] Body row 2: SI1, P1, K1, P11, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P12, K1, P2.

-Repeat these two rows until measures 175 cm or however long you want it.

-Resume broken ribbing pattern by knitting rib row 1 on [WS] (i.e. after a body row 1 (on WS) until ribbing measures the same as the beginning ribbing. Cast off .

Finishing:

Wash in lukewarm water and block vigorously.

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
